POSITION SUMMARY:

Reporting to the Recreation Programmer, the Child & Youth Instructors will facilitate preschool and children's recreation programs within Loyalist Township. Programs can range from art classes to physical activity classes.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS AND SKILLS:

- Previous experience working with children in a recreation instructional position
- Post-secondary education related to Childhood Development and/or Recreation and Leisure Services is preferred
- HIGH FIVE Principals of Healthy Child Development is an asset
- An acceptable criminal reference check (CPIC), including vulnerable sector screening, completed within the last six months
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR C certification

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Plan and deliver program activities that ensure a warm, welcoming, and safe environment
- Set up and take down recreational, program and other equipment as required –checking that equipment is safe and in good repair (reporting any equipment malfunctions or safety issues to the Recreation Programmer)
- Ensure participants are attended into the class by verifying class lists in the Recreation Management Software, PerfectMind
- Develop positive and professional relationships with participants
- Enforce all rules and regulations and maintain order in designated program as a proactive approach to ensuring safety and accident prevention
- Take responsibility for the maintenance and cleanliness of program areas
- Responsible as an employee for health and safety, including working safely within requirements of legislation and policies, reporting hazards, and maintaining a safe and
