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### **POSITION SUMMARY:**

The role of Head Basketball Coach will be to lead the Breaker's Basketball program and focus on the development of specific skills like shooting, passing, dribbling, and balance. The Head Coach will be responsible for overseeing all drills, scrimmages, and to mentor and develop the other basketball coaches. Coaches will use fun games and activities to engage the participants, to learn and develop the basic basketball skills and participate in scrimmages. The ideal candidate will have experience leading recreational sport programming and an understanding of the game of basketball.
