It was named for the United Empire Loyalists, who settled in the area after the American Revolution. The Township was formed on January 1, 1998, through the amalgamation of Amherst Island Township, Ernestown Township, and the Village of Bath.

Loyalist Township is a growing community of 18,000+ people situated on the north shore of Lake Ontario between the Town of Greater Napanee and the City of Kingston.

The Township is a blend of rural and urban areas with a number of smaller hamlets throughout, including an island community, accessible by ferry.
