Questions and Answers during Covid-19 – Updated February 10, 2021

Q - Are construction project now allowed to start or resume if they were paused during the stay at home order?

A – Yes, provided a building permit has been issued.

Q - Are residential additions or renovations allowed to start or continue?

A - Yes, provided a building permit has been issued.

Q - Is Loyalist Township still accepting Building Permit applications?

A – Loyalist Township is still accepting building permit applications, reviewing plans, and processing applications remotely. Applications can be submitted electronically at amacpherson@loyalist.ca

Q – With the office closed to the Public, how are building permit fees submitted?

A - Payments are accepted by calling 613-386-7351 extension 170 and arranging for payment once you are notified that your permit is ready for issue. Payment is by Cheque only. Once the Offices are open to the public by appointment on February 16th Debit transactions will be allowed

Q - Are there any restrictions on inspections that can continue during the emergency order?

A - Yes, for staff and public safety, Inspectors will be following O.reg 10/21; any inspection may be refused by inspectors for reasons of occupational health and safety. If an inspection has been refused, the work must stop or be completed by other means of inspection approved by the inspector.
