

## **Mayoral Decision 2025-11**

Date: Tuesday, October 14, 2025

Re: Written approval of the by-law enacted on October 14, 2025

**WHEREAS** section 284.11(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001 (the "Act") prescribes that if the head of council is of the opinion that all or part of a by-law that could potentially interfere with a prescribed provincial priority, the head of council may provide written notice to the council of the intent to consider vetoing the by-law;

**AND WHEREAS** section 284.11(4) of the Act provides that a by-law shall be deemed not to have been passed by council until the earlier of,

- (i) the day written approval of the by-law is given by the head of council to the municipality;
- (ii) two days after the day council voted in favour of the by-law where notice under Section 284.11(3) of the Act was not given; or
- (iii) 14 days after the day the council voted in favour of the by-law where notice under Section 284.11(3) of the Act was given.

NOW THEREFORE I, Jim Hegadorn, Mayor of Loyalist Township hereby approve

1. All the items approved by the Confirmation By-law 2025-60 enacted on October 14, 2025.
