Delegations and Presentations

Community Safety and Wellbeing Plan

Karie Warner, Avail Consulting Inc. and Kathryn Manners, Kathryn Manners Consulting, presented an overview of the draft Joint Community Safety Wellbeing Plan for Loyalist Township and Greater Napanee.

Bus Service in Odessa

Susan Blay spoke regarding improvement to transportation needs for the elderly in the Odessa area.

Green Municipal Fund Funding Agreement - 237 Jim Snow Drive Feasibility Study

Council approved entering into a funding agreement with the Federation of Canadian Municipalities for 237 Jim Snow Drive Feasibility Study.

Results of Tender 2023-16 - Odessa West Reconstruction and Stormwater Improvements

Council approved that K Mulrooney Trucking Limited be awarded Tender 2023-16 Odessa West Reconstruction and Stormwater Improvements and authorized the pre-budget approval for 2024 of \$491,800.

Potential Road Closing - 5526 Bath Road- Response to Resolution 2022.1.4

Council approved the potential road closing at 5526 Bath Road and that an appraisal be required as part of the road closing and sale application process to determine the fair market value of the land.

Short Term Accommodations

Council directed staff to further review and report back on potential Zoning By-law regulations pertaining to short term accommodations as part of the Comprehensive Zoning By-law Review and that staff monitor complaints related to short term accommodations (STAs) and report back to Council

with recommendations on a potential Licensing By-law if negative impacts from STAs are appearing in the Township.

Implementation of Bill 109 - More Homes For Everyone Act, 2022

Bill 109 - *More Homes for Everyone Act* was introduced on March 30, 2022 and given Royal Assent on April 14, 2022. Council received this report for information.

D14-002-2023 - 2862429 Ontario Inc., Ready Mix Cement Plant - Request to Remove Holding Symbol

Council approved the report and passed By-Law 2023-029 to remove the holding symbol with respect to Part of Lots 19, 20, 21 & 22 Concession 1 and 2.

Approval of the Community Safety and Well-Being Plan (CSWBP)

Council approved the plan and adopted the draft CSWBP as a three-year plan.
