Statutory Public Meetings

A public meeting was held in accordance with the provisions of Section 28 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, to consider amendments to the [Affordable and Purpose-Built Rental Housing CIP](#). The proposed amendments will create two new financial incentives for the redevelopment, construction and reconstruction of land and buildings to support the focus of this CIP.

A public meeting was held in accordance with the provisions of 34(12) of the Planning Act to consider a [Zoning By-Law Amendment submitted by Kaitlin Corporation \(2238052 Ontario Ltd.\)](#). The proposed amendment to Zoning By-law 2001-38, as amended, seek to rezone the subject lands from Open Space (OS) Zone to Residential Type Two Exception Fifteen Holding (R2-15-H) Zone, Residential Type Three Exception Twenty-Three Holding (R3-23-H) Zone, and Residential Type Three Exception Twenty-Eight Holding (R3-28-H) Zone to facilitate the development of 47 single detached dwelling units.

Council heard in person or by their counsel, solicitor, or agent, any person who claims to be affected by these applications.

- Council directed staff to provide a report considering the advisability, feasibility and operational considerations relating to the potential drafting of a bylaw regulating smoking and vaporizing in public places and enclosed workplaces.
