## **Accessible Transit Services Agreement - Kingston Area Taxi Commission (KATC)**

Loyalist Township will enter into an agreement with the KATC for a period of one year. The report provides an update on the status of the subsidized pilot of the accessible taxi service for the Route 10 transit service area. The estimated cost of the service in 2023 is \$98,000 for the period of the pilot. The accessible service will be essential for individuals living in Amherstview. It should be noted that this pilot service is separate from the pilot that is being planned for the industrial area through the use of County funding which will come as a separate report to Council.

## **Agreement for the Construction and Maintenance of County Roads and Bridges**

Loyalist Township will execute an agreement with the County of Lennox and Addington for the construction and maintenance of County roads and will formally request the County to conduct a review of the County road network. Staff will complete a fulsome review of the agreement for the construction and maintenance of county roads and bridges to ensure the Loyalist costs to provide the services to the County are satisfactorily captured in the agreement.

## **Update of Proclamation, Public Awareness, and Flag Flying Policy**

Council approved the recommendations to amend the policy relating to half-masting of flags, taking into consideration both the National Flag of Canada etiquette as well as the government of Canada and Heritage Canada rules for half-masting the National Flag of Canada.

## **Aquatic Programming Options for Township Residents**

Council directed staff to negotiate agreements with regional aquatic facility operators for use of their aquatic facilities and or aquatic programming partnerships. In addition to the above partnerships, staff have discussed a proposed partnership with the Lakeshore Swimming Pool Association, specifically to offer the key leadership courses required by lifeguards and swimming instructors which will assist in addressing staffing challenges.

## **Babcock Mills Phases 2, 3, & 4 Plan of Subdivision**

Council received the report and approved By-law 2023-026 to assume one foot reserves, described as Block 27 on 29M-66, Block 66 on Plan 29M-64 and Block 53 on 29M-56.
