





Grey Box Recycling - Paper and Fibre



Flexible Plastic Packaging
Bags used for dry cleaning,
bread, newspapers and
flyers. Coffee bags or deli
pouches, chip bags, bubble
wrap etc.



Empty and free from food residue.



Paper Laminate Packaging

Pizza boxes, direct mail boxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes.



Empty and free from food residue.



Card board Boxes

Pizza boxes, direct mail boxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes.



Flatten

No larger than 60 x 60 cm.



Paper Laminate Containers

Spiral cans, cookie dough package, ice cream containers, and hot and cold beverage cups.



Empty and free from food residue. Remove lids.



Boxboard

Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, rolls from toilet paper and paper towel.



Flatten. Empty.



Paper

Community newspaper, flyers, flour bags, notepads, file folders.



Empty. Remove rope from bags.
Separate from plastic bags used to cover items, remove elastic bands.



Do not include soft or hard covered books.



Cartons

Beverage cartons, juice and milk cartons, coffee creamers, and sugar cartons, soup and sauce cartons.



Empty and free from food residue.
Keep lids on.



Do not include alcohol beverage containers.





Blue Box Recycling - Plastic, Foam, Metal & Glass



Hard Plastic Containers
Laundry detergent and
cleaner jugs, shampoo,
body wash, salad dressing,
condiment, dish soap,
mouth wash bottles.





Plastic Packaging and Containers

Food trays, yogurt, peanut butter, bakery and egg containers, plastic tubs and lids.

Empty and Do not include free from alcoholic food residue. beverage Keep lids on. containers.



Tubes

Toothpaste tubes, deodorant, hand cream tubes.



Empty and free from residue. Keep lids on.



Small Item Plastic Packaging

Hand sanitizer bottles, medication bottles, blister packs, plant pots.



Empty and free from food and residue.
Keep lids on.



Metal Containers

Food cans, metal lids, cookie, coffee and tea tins, beverage cans.



Empty and free from food residue.



Do not include alcoholic beverage containers.



Foam Packaging

Meat trays, takeout containers, cups, plates, bowls, foam packaging for products.



Empty and free from food residue. Remove film wrap and absorbent pads from meat trays.



Aerosal Containers

Food spray, hairspray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant.



Empty and Lids On.



Aluminum (foils and Trays)

Aluminum foil, pie plates, frozen food trays.



Empty and free from food residue. Ball up aluminum foil.



Glass Containers

Clear and coloured glass. Food containers, jars and bottles etc.



Empty and free from residue. Lids off.



Do not include alcoholic beverage containers.

Waste Collection

Collection Locations: Garbage & Recycling is collected in all wards of Loyalist Township except Amherst Island where they must be delivered to the Amherst Island Landfill.


Collection Timing: Garbage & recycling must be at the curb by 7am and both are usually collected before 5pm.

Bag Tags: Every garbage bag needs a tag.

The following restrictions apply:

- Maximum weight is 40lbs/18kgs per bag/can
- Bags no larger than 30in x 38in/75cm x 95cm or a can size of 17 gallons/77 litres
- Tags are \$3.00 each, sold in sheets of 10

To keep tires out of landfills, tire producers are responsible for ensuring used tires are collected and recycled or reused. To find a collection site, visit the Resource Productivity & Resource Authority website at rpra.ca/programs/tires Collection sites in Loyalist include Amherstview Auto and O'Neill's Auto.

FLIDO (Free Large Item Disposal Opportunities)

Residents can use their two annual FLIDOs anytime during landfill operating hours, including select summer/fall Saturdays. Regular disposal fees apply to these items.

What You Can Bring (Large Items Only): Appliances (fridges, freezers, washers, dryers, stoves), Large furniture, Bicycle frames or similar metal items, Fencing (posts removed), Aluminum siding, Rolls of flooring, Air conditioners.

What Cannot be Brought: Anything that fits in a regular garbage bag, Household garbage, Construction or renovation waste, Tires.

Load Limit: Each FLIDO = one pickup-truck load (8 ft × 4 ft × 2 ft).

HHW (Household Hazardous Waste)

Residents may dispose of HHW at the Kingston Area Recycling Centre (KARC). HHW waste cannot go in your garbage and must be diverted from landfills.

The Water Leak Forgiveness Adjustment Policy provides metered single family unit water supply customers an opportunity to request financial assistance in the form of a credit for abnormally high and unintentional water bill charges.



Building Permits

You need a building permit for most construction projects, including building or changing a structure, adding heating or plumbing, or constructing a deck. A permit is also required for pools, hot tubs, woodstoves, and stand-alone structures larger than 161 sq. ft (15 m²).



Property Taxes

Property taxes are levied by the Township and provide the main source of revenue to deliver services supplied by the Township. Confirmed tax dates for 2026: February 27 and April 30th. Tentiative tax dates for 2026: September 29th and June 30th.
